

IMPORTANT PARKING NOTICE:
Northside Forsyth Parking Update - Faculty & Students

Thank you for participating in clinical rotations at our Northside Hospital Forsyth campus. As part of our ongoing efforts to improve our facilities and services, we are enhancing our parking areas. Effective August 11th, all students, visiting faculty, and clinical faculty will be required to utilize off-site parking. Your cooperation in utilizing off-site parking helps ensure that our patients have convenient access to hospital parking during this construction period. Students should wear their school-issued picture ID when boarding the bus. You will not be asked to scan anything upon boarding the bus.

The parking shuttles' hours of operation are Monday through Friday from 5 a.m. to 9 p.m. each day. There will not be shuttle services from Friday at 9 p.m. through the weekend. Shuttle services will restart on Mondays at 5 a.m. Shuttle services will not be provided on holidays or weekends. When the shuttle is not in service, students may park at any on-site employee lot or on the 3rd and 4th floors of the parking deck.

The address for the Cumming Fairgrounds Surface Parking Lot is 320 Castleberry Road, Cumming, GA 30040. There are signs highlighting the two entrances. Please park close to the tent and then fill in the spaces from there.
